Airport Information The InterContinental Presidente is approximately 18 km/11 mi from Mexico City's Benito Juarez International Airport (MEX).

The InterContinental Presidente offers a car service that will provide transportation from the airport to the hotel. The cost is 720 pesos, or approximately \$56 USD. To arrange for this service, call the hotel at +52-55-53277700 and the concierge will assist in making the arrangements.

Taxis are also available at the airport. The approximate charge for a taxi is \$18 USD for the 30-45 minute ride.

Directions **By Car:** From the airport take the road Viaducto to Chapultepec exit. Proceed to Calle Arquimedes Street. Cross Arquimedes and turn to your left on Calle Campos Eliseos, it leads you directly to the hotel.

By Subway: The InterContinental is located 0.2 km/0.12 mi from the Auditorio subway station on Line 7.
